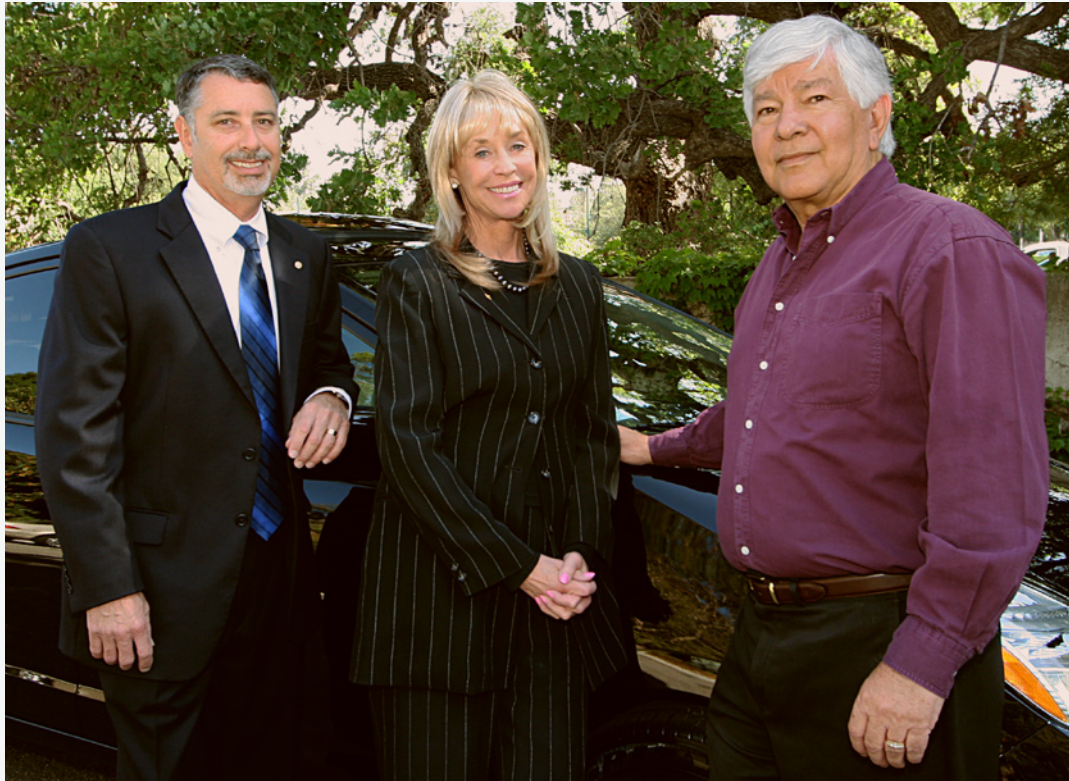


THOUSAND OAKS TOYOTA DRIVES A GOOD BARGAIN FOR LOCAL ROTARY CLUB.
